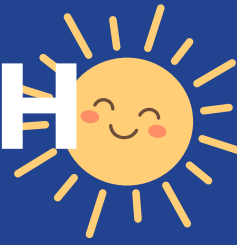

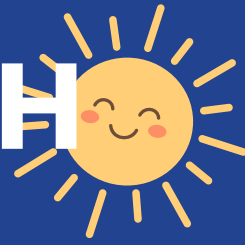
- **Financial Assistance Fund**
